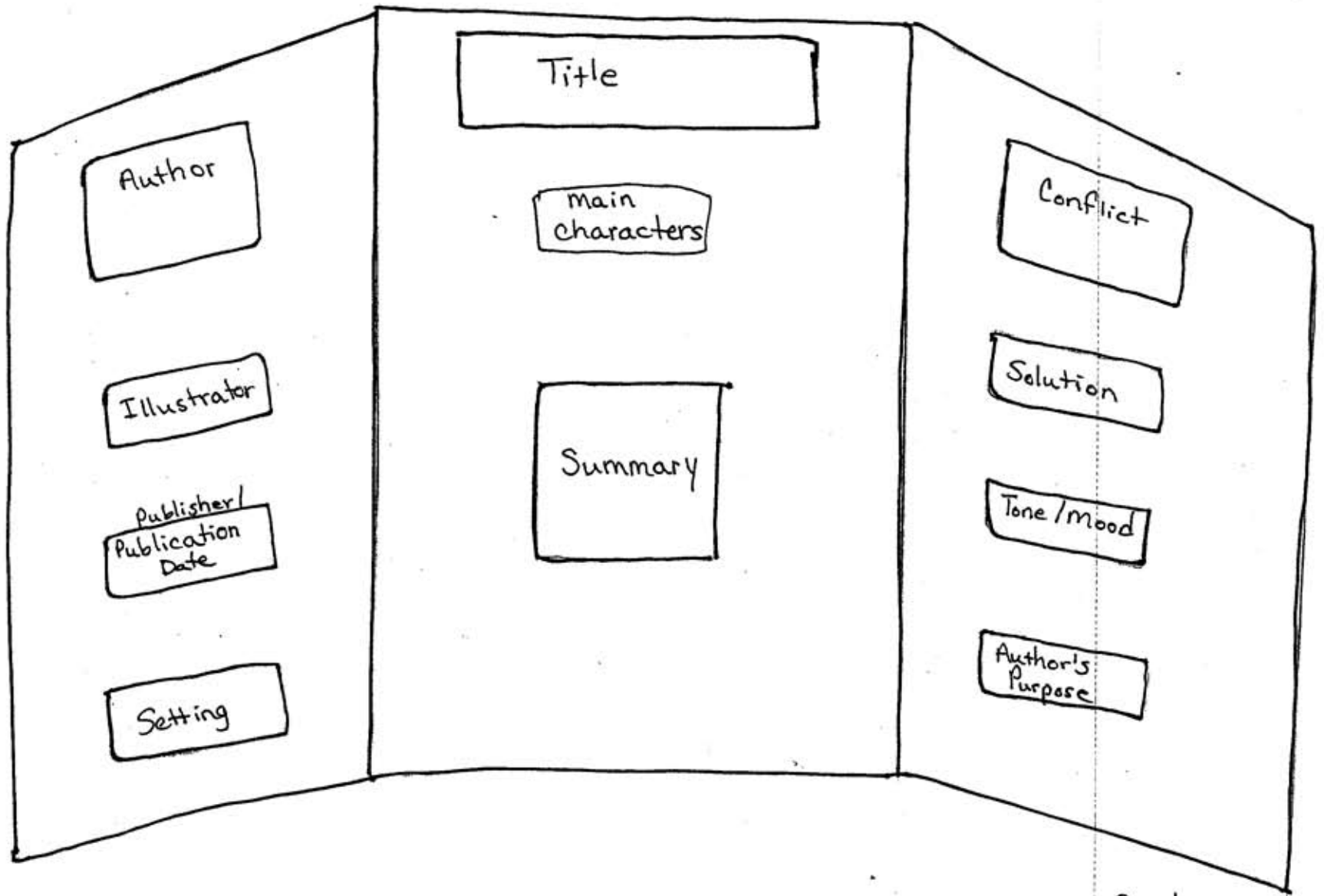


Elements to Include on Your Storyboard for the Reading Fair



* This is a diagram to help your child complete a Reading Fair Project. This is just an example of how to place the needed elements on your storyboard.

Elements to Include on your Storyboard

10 points will be taken from your score if all elements are not on the board

1. TITLE
2. AUTHOR/ *Illustrator*
3. PUBLISHER AND PUBLICATION DATE
4. SETTING- place and time of the story
5. MAIN CHARACTER-only those important to the story line
6. PLOT SUMMARY—brief summary(not retelling) of what the story is about and what takes place
7. CONFLICT-the problem in the story
8. SOLUTION or RESOLUTION-how the problem is resolved
9. AUTHOR'S PURPOSE-why the author wrote the story-(to entertain, inform, persuade, combination of purposes)
10. TONE or MOOD – the tone affects the feelings of the reader, or how the author wants the reader to feel when reading the story
